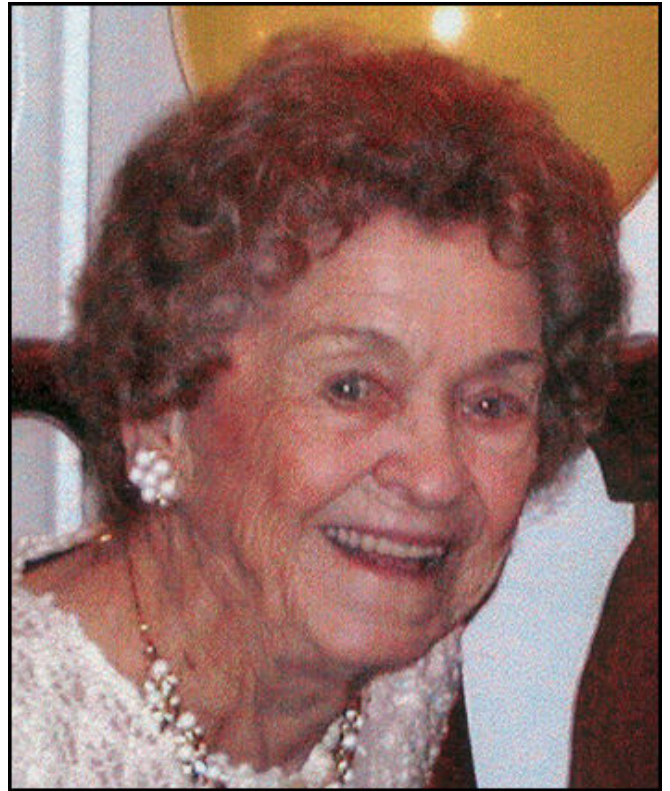


GENEVA “Grandma Toots” SMITH – 1/10/1912 – 5/31/04
